John, a Quaker, suffered a great deal of persecution in England culminating in his imprisonment for religious offenses. His wife's relatives freed him and immigrated to Penn's Colony in 1683 before there was a single house in Philadelphia. John and his family settled in Darby, PA west of Darby Creek.

William Bartram received 200 acres in Darby Township from his father John. He served as Supervisor of Darby Township in 1706, and member of Provincial Assembly from Chester County in 1708.

December 22, 1709 he acquired 2 tracts of land on Bogue Sound, White Oak River, Carteret County, NC. In the fall of 1710 he moved his second wife and family to North Carolina. September 22, 1711, he was killed in an uprising of Tuscarora Indians. His wife Elizabeth and two children were taken hostage, but rescued and returned to Philadelphia

in late 1712.
